Dear Chief Kraus,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. This week we created a petition asking for an investigation into suspected dog-fighting activity in Fort Worth. A video, which is being widely circulated on social media, shows two male suspects forcing a tethered dog to swim for an extended period of time - a method which dog fighters incorporate to condition dogs to fight. The footage was taken at Lake Arlington, on the west side, at Eugene McCray Park. The video, which begins with the dog already in the water swimming, lasts for 28 minutes - this is outright cruelty and **over 10,200 people signed our petition** asking for a full investigation.

We look forward to hearing back from you about the effort your department is making to find and punish the men involved. Thank you for your work on this important cruelty case.
