Dear Mr. Sexton,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition on behalf of a dog who died at the end of a tether in Montgomery County, Ohio. The Rottweiler suffered horribly before dying in the heat and we are hopeful that an investigation will lead to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible.

It is our understanding that this dog was left outside, tethered to a tree, in 90-degree heat, for days. At the bare minimum, this is gross negligence, if not outright animal cruelty on the part of the person who owned this dog. Attached you will find our petition, with over **14,500 signatures**.

We hope to hear back from you with an update for the thousands of people who signed the petition.

Thank you for your time and consideration with this important animal cruelty case.
