Dear Prosecuting Attorney Robnett,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for Elmer James Givens Jr. to be denied his request to regain custody of the 36 dogs and puppies which were seized from his home in Pierce County. This is the second time that the authorities have taken dogs from Givens' property. In December 2019, 50 dogs were taken from Givens home, and there was evidence found at his property of dog fighting activity.

**Nearly 11,000 people have signed our petition** (please see link below for signatures and comments) asking for Givens to not only be denied his rights to these dogs, but to face charges for the conditions they were found in. It is our understanding that the authorities have found strong evidence of dog fighting and it is our hope that Givens will face the appropriate charges for his participation in the detestable "blood sport."

We look forward to hearing back from your office about this important animal cruelty case. Thank you for your time and consideration.
