Dear City Prosecutor,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for Ra'shae Syrtaj Jermaine Johnson to receive the maximum punishment for his fifth-degree felony charge of animal cruelty. Johnson admitted to setting fire to a plastic crate with a puppy inside, and over **14,400 people** signed our petition asking for him to receive the maximum punishment for his crime. We are aware that your agency worked tirelessly to investigate this crime and apprehend Mr. Johnson, and it is our hope that you can forward our petition (please see link below for signatures and comments) to the appropriate officials who will be handling this case in court.
