Dear District Attorney Cronin,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for Curtis Swan and Aaleyah Clay to receive the maximum punishment for charges resulting from the abandonment of a husky named Carter. It is our understanding that Swan and Clay packed up their belongings and moved out of state, leaving their dog tethered outside to a fence.

Had this dog not been found, he would have suffered a slow and painful death. **Over 15,100 people** have signed our petition (please see link for signatures and comments) asking for this couple receive the maximum sentence for their charges of third-degree causing serious bodily injury to a domesticated animal via neglect, and abandonment of a domesticated animal, a disorderly persons offense, AND be forbidden from ever owning a pet again in the future.

This couple does not deserve a plea deal - it would only diminish the cruelty of their actions. We look forward to hearing back from your office about the status of this important animal cruelty case, and we will be in touch again soon if we do not receive the courtesy of a response.
