We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We created a petition asking for a revision to Ponce's Law, which currently allows convicted animal killers like Travis Archer, to own a pet again.

We, and **16,567 of our supporters**, believe that animal abusers like Travis Archer should never be given the opportunity to own a pet again. As you are certainly well aware, Travis Archer beat his Labrador retriever, Ponce, savagely in 2017. The brutal attack, which ended Ponce's life, prompted the creation of Ponce's Law, which is a vital step forward for animal welfare. However, as it is currently written, it falls short for convicted animal abusers.

Attached you will find our petition, which includes signatures and comments from like-minded individuals who want to see Ponce's Law changed to include a lifetime ban of pet ownership for all convicted animal abusers.
