Dear District Attorney Lisa Jeanes,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. This week we created a petition asking for the person who allowed their dog to freeze to death, outside of a home in Davis City, to be arrested and charged. What happened to this dog is inexcusable and in violation of Iowa's Code 717B, which states, that "owners are required to provide shelter that protects the animals from the elements: Ventilated shelter reasonably sufficient to provide adequate protection from the elements and weather conditions suitable for the age, species, and physical condition of the animal so as to maintain the animal in a state of good health to the extent that the animal's health or life is endangered."

We want to make sure that you aware of our petition, which currently has **24,351 signatures**. We hope to see the sheriff enforce the law with a full investigation and charges against the dog's owner if the results of the necropsy support an arrest.
