Attention: Tribal Vice Chairman Edmond Tilousi and the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA)

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners from AnimalVictory.org. We have created a petition calling for an end to the ongoing mistreatment of the Havasupai pack animals. These animals help provide a living for the Havasupai people and they should be treated with care and respect. Instead, there is evidence that they are frequently forced to carry loads which are far too heavy, in extreme heat. Conditions are so bad at times that the horses and mules collapse on the trails...sometimes dying. This is completely unacceptable and must end.

Treating these animals poorly is not only cruel, but it is bad for business. More and more people are leaving damning TripAdvisor reviews about the guided pack experience and in the end, this will reduce the number of people who choose to utilize the services of wranglers with pack animals. The guidelines for the Bureau of Indian Affairs with regards to pack animal treatment must be enforced. It is critical that these animals be provided with proper care, including plentiful food, water, adequate rest, and packs that are not too heavy.

We look forward to hearing back from you. It is our hope that we will be able to provide a promising update to the individuals who have signed the attached petition.
