We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We created a petition to raise awareness of the cruel horse killings in Floyd County, Kentucky. At the time that the petition was created, a total of 15 horses had been found dead from gunshot wounds. Since that time, more dead horses have been discovered, but to our knowledge, nobody has been arrested for these killings.

We are aware the Floyd County Sheriff's Office is investigating this cruelty situation and we are hopeful that there is an update to share with the 7225 people who have signed our petition.
