We created a petition on February 3 with regards to the novel coronavirus and the ensuing panic among Chinese residents who are killing their pets out of misguided fear that the virus will spread among cats and dogs and ultimately harm humans. Within four days 7517 people signed the petition.

The World Health Organization has already stated that companion animals are not at risk of contracting the coronavirus and it has advised that they were not the source of the outbreak. In fact, the source of this deadly virus has been linked to the exotic meat market (wet market) in Wuhan. We are of the understanding that there is a temporary ban on the sale of exotic meats (koala, bat, snake, rats and more) but we believe these markets should be permanently closed due to the health repercussions for not only Chinese residents, but the entire world.
