Dear Mr. Champion,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for the owner of a Tate County breeding operation to be brought up on charges for the gross neglect of the dogs found living there. Over 170 dogs were rescued from the property in Coldwater, Mississippi, and the conditions were so bad that it was described as "Hell on Earth."

While we understand that the individual running this breeding operation had a license, we believe that it does not excuse the condition of the dogs who were kept there, and used for to make their owner money. Dogs taken from the property were filthy, matted and injured. The dogs were being kept in dilapidated wooden structures, and many, if not all, were never provided with any form of creature comfort or freedom.

It is our understanding that Ashkraft Kennels is the business operating the puppy mill and we are hopeful that the kennel owner will be facing criminal charges for the horrible condition of the dogs found on the property. We hope to hear back from you about the status of this case. Over 4300 people signed the petition (linked below) and we would like to update them about any potential charges pending. Thank you for your time and consideration.
