We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for Matthew Wydrinski of Mercer County, New Jersey, to be punished for the death of a four-year-old dog named Tori. It is our understanding that this dog was slowly starved to death and not provided with veterinary help which would have saved her life. To our knowledge, Tori was a healthy dog when the Wydrinski family adopted her, and within four months she dropped down to just 18 pounds and died from apparent starvation.

There is a heart-wrenching video of Tori's final moments alive- she is under a towel, too weak to raise her head, and struggling to even breathe. Next to her face is a clean, empty dog food bowl that has never been used. In the background the sounds of children playing video games can be heard...feet away from the dog who is suffering a painful death.

This terrible situation has struck a cord with thousands of people. In fact, nearly 21,000 people have currently signed the petition asking for Wydrinski to be punished for Tori's gross lack of care.

We are hopeful that we can continue to be updated about the status of this cruelty investigation and the case against Matthew Wydrinski. Thank you for your time and consideration.
