On December 4, 2019, the East Windsor Police Department received a report of possible animal cruelty. The report was in response to a Facebook post containing a video of a sick dog, where the owner was requesting assistance. Subsequent to the post, the severely under-nourished female pit bull, died. Following a joint investigation with the Mercer County Prosecutor's Office, the defendant was arrested and released pending court action.
