We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for Dennis Sugar, of Sussex County, to be punished for gross neglect of animals at his petting zoo. It is our understanding that more than 30 dead pigs, as well as numerous malnourished and ailing pigs and goats, were discovered at the Sugar Sweet Farms petting zoo.

Nearly 4500 people signed our petition (linked below) asking for Sugar to be given a strong punishment for the death of these innocent animals who relied on him for care. Additionally, it is our hope that this petting zoo be shut down and Sugar forbidden from owning animals in the future.
