STUDENTS & SCHOOLS

Dario championed legislation to increase school funding, helping put more money in every classroom across the state. He also voted for meaningful reforms to improve student learning and help keep the best teachers in our schools.

TRANSPORTATION SOLUTIONS

WORKING FOR EDINA

- **Working for Edina Families and Students:** Because of Dario's leadership, Edina families will finally have top priority to send their children to Edina schools. The new law he authored streamlines the enrollment lottery process which was a priority for many Edina families with school-aged children in our community.
- **Advocating for Higher Education:** Dario advocated for additional funding for the University of Minnesota and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and also helped secure a tuition freeze at two and four year Minnesota State campuses for the 2018-19 school year. In addition, he voted for a first-in-the-nation tax credit for graduates with student loan debt.
- **Supporting Health Care Reform:** Dario supported a 25 percent premium reduction for Minnesotans hurt by skyrocketing costs on the individual market, as well as a number of meaningful reforms to increase affordability, choice and access to health insurance for families and small businesses in Edina and across the state.
- **Championing Laws with an Everyday Impact:** Dario supported legislation that were priorities for Edina constituents including REAL ID compliance to ensure a Minnesota driver's license will continue to be a valid form of identification across the nation, Sunday alcohol sales, and an initiative that will bring 5G wireless technology to the Twin Cities.
