 - i. Pay transparency - minimum wage was first campaign, but research and survey around pay transparency is a slow process due to difficulty of securely gathering useful and robust data (longer term project)
 - ii. Working conditions - contract FAQs and one-on-one member support, but space for future coordinated campaigns and advice guides.
Future campaigns around draft policies for employers re: remote and flexible work, overtime, open offices. Transparency around what to expect in the sector
 - iii. International / migrant workers - collecting stories and making it easier for people to share anonymously so we can advocate for transparent conditions and provide support
