Letters to the Land is a community project that holds intentional space for BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Colour) to express their climate anxiety and critically reflect on their relationship to land. Through a facilitated writing workshop (closed for BIPOC) (“Reroot”) as well as an open community showcase (“Revival”), this project encourages participants to vision a future together that supports & prioritizes the healing and recovery of BIPOC communities, lands, and knowledge.
