



Housing Subsidies Available for Persons Who Exited Ohio Prisons After April 1, 2019 And Participated in Recovery Services While Incarcerated

CSH and our housing partners listed below are seeking to help individuals who are homeless, have no safe place to go upon release or are unstably housed. Do you know someone who needs help securing affordable housing and was released from prison in the last year, and who participated in recovery services while incarcerated? Please contact us ASAP.

The Community Transition Program “CTP,” funded by the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services, will be ramping up our housing program to help ease the burden on shelters and other community providers during this period of national emergency. Program requirements that limit eligibility to those who were released less than 120 days ago are being eased to allow us to serve more people. CTP housing provides rental subsidy and home-based supportive services for eligible persons and their families.
