# SMOKE, VAPE AND TOBACCO-FREE FACILITIES

### **Background**

Smoking, vaping and the use of tobacco products in any form by students, employees and other persons are not conducive to the maintenance of a healthy environment. All Division premises and vehicles will be smoke, vape and tobacco free, and all school-sponsored activities shall be smoke, vape and tobacco free.

#### **Procedures**

- 1. All Division buildings, vehicles (including private vehicles used for Division business) and grounds are designated smoke, vape and tobacco free.
- 2. The Principal shall ensure all students, staff, parents, visitors and community user-groups are made aware of the smoke, vape and tobacco-free requirement.
- 3. Smoking, vaping and the use of tobacco products are prohibited at any school-sponsored graduation ceremony or activity.
- 4. Supervisors shall inform their staff members that the use of tobacco is prohibited in or on Division-owned property.
- 5. Any student or staff member in violation of these procedures will be dealt with in accordance with the disciplinary procedures established at each site.
- 6. With the prior approval of the Principal or supervisor, the use of tobacco is permitted as part of religious/ceremonial events.
