We Pacific Islanders are family orientated. We come from big families. Church is our biggest love and we congregate. We are always connecting with the community. God is our number one. Being vaccinated means that we as Pacific Islanders can continue to congregate and continue to connect with the community. We love gatherings and we love getting together with our families. We go to church to do activities. We love signing, dancing, going to the beach and group BBQs.

As Pacific Islanders we get vaccinated because we believe in God. Getting vaccinated will allows us to continue to come together, to meet in church and to congregate with each other and our families. We want to have a normal life as much as we can, we can only congregate as a community if we are fully vaccinated. Getting the vaccination will let us continue our lives and our culture as Pacific Islanders.
