## Privacy Policy

Your privacy is important to us. The Atlantica Party will respect your privacy through the protection of any of your personal information that you provide to us. We take great care to keep both confidential and secure all personal information in our possession.

- Personal Identifiable Information (PII) is information about an identifiable individual. It includes information such as name, address, e-mail address, telephone number and other contact information.
- Elections Nova Scotia provides all political parties with a list of electors, including names and postal addresses.
- By law we are required to:
  - Publically disclose the full name, residential address and total annual contribution to The Party of contributors when in excess of two hundred dollars.
  - Keep records of donors for tax purposes.
- We collect PII from donors and members when they contribute to our Party or purchase a membership. You may also choose to provide us with PII on a voluntary basis, such as when registering for an event or signing a petition.
- If you submit your e-mail address and/or PII to us, you consent to being added to our e-mail list. You may unsubscribe from our e-mail list at any time using the link provided in each email message or by contacting us.
- We use your PII to communicate with you. As a political party, we believe it is important to communicate with the public on a regular basis.
- As a provincial organization with a riding-based membership system, your PII may be disclosed to our local riding associations, who may also communicate with you.
- We maintain security systems to safeguard your PII from unauthorized access, disclosure or misuse, and from loss or unauthorized alteration.
- We will not sell your PII that you have chosen to provide us.
