## Atlantica Party Constitution

The official governing document for the Atlantica Party Association of Nova Scotia. Version 1.1

### 1. Aim

1.1. The aim of the Constitution is to promote the interests of the Atlantica Party of Nova Scotia (the Party) by providing effective and efficient operation of the Party.

### 2. Executive Committee

2.1. The Executive Committee of the Party shall at a minimum consist of: The President, Secretary, Leader, Treasurer, and Agent. No one may hold two of these positions. The Executive Committee may add additional Director roles to the Committee as required.

2.2. The Executive Committee shall have full authority to act on behalf of the Party in all matters through a majority vote that includes the Leader.

2.3. A quorum for business is 40% of the members of the current Executive Committee including the Leader.

2.4. The Executive Committee shall meet at the call of the President or the Leader.

2.5. Vacant positions have no vote and personnel occupying more than one position count only as one vote.

### 3. Changes

3.1. Changes to this Constitution require a two-thirds majority including the Leader.

### 4. Roles

4.1. The President shall call, ensure attendance and efficiency as chair of Executive meetings of the Party. Also provide leadership on party governance and serve as spokesperson when needed.

4.2. The Treasurer shall receive all monies belonging to the Party, keep a record of the same and, at the direction of the Executive Committee, shall pay all debts incurred.

4.3. The Secretary shall keep full and correct records of the meetings of the Executive Committee and circulate copies of all minutes to the Executive Committee.

4.4. The Agent shall ensure all aspects of the Party are in accordance with the Elections Act of Nova Scotia and Elections Nova Scotia. The Agent will also be considered a party Director.
