## I. Constitutional amendments

Proposed amendments to the AUJS Constitution must be submitted to the Returning Officer no later than 11:59pm on Monday August 12th, 2019.

No amendments can be accepted after this date, in order that the returning officer may provide 14 days' notice to all constituent organisations under point 16.1 of the constitution.

## II. Nominations

Nomination forms for election must be submitted to the Returning Officer by 5:00pm on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2019. Pending any amendments to the Constitution, positions up for election are:

- Chairperson
- Vice Chairperson
- Treasurer
- Political Affairs Director
- Conferences Convener
- Campaigns Coordinator
- Leadership and Development Officer
- Jewish Engagement Officer

*The acceptance of nominations after this date will be at the discretion of the Returning Officer.*

## III. Voting

The AUJS Constitution outlines voting and electoral procedures for general meetings, including the applicable standing orders attached in Appendix C.

Section 9 of the Constitution stipulates the procedure for calculating the number of votes.

In line with the membership requirements of s 9.2 of the Constitution, the following affiliate organisations – campuses – are entitled to votes provided at least 10 financial members. The president of each campus must submit to the Returning Officer a list of all financial members in 2019, including the date and cost of membership, by 5:00 PM on 12th August 2019.

Any campus organisations which are not listed below can be added by way of Constitutional Amendment.

#### **IV. Eligibility to vote**

Constituent and affiliate organisations will be informed of voting eligibility and procedure once the number of members of your region or campus has been verified.

Note: (i) a delegate may not hold more than two votes, (ii) a vote must ordinarily be held by a delegate from the relevant region or campus, (iii) where a vote is to be held by a delegate not from the relevant region or campus, a proxy form will be required (see the [website](#)).

Votes will not be awarded to regions or campuses that do not submit membership lists, or were not active under 9.2.1.
