I am an Environmental Engineer who has spent the past 10 years as a consultant - helping businesses to meet international standards for environmental management and to manage environmental risks. This role has highlighted the change in business risk tolerance towards stakeholders (like shareholders and the community). The social licence to operate and shareholder concerns, mixed with the communication power of social media, has given greater power to individuals to influence for change within large organisations. I am passionate about seeing this change and ensuring we balance economic and environmental risks for inter-generational equity.

Advocacy and community engagement

Pre-COVID I was living in Melbourne where I had involvement with administrative work for the Animal Justice Party and Engineers Without Borders. I also got very sore feet walking kilometres in the warehouse at FoodBank, where I helped to pack pallets for delivery to food charities across the state.

Governance interest and experience

My work as a compliance auditor begins with understanding the governance and risk frameworks which underpin the business or organisation that I am assessing. Through this work I have had exposure to a huge range of different structures and audited both the inputs and outputs of Boards and Committees. I enjoy adding value to these structures through determining opportunities for improvement, based on what I have seen across the huge variety of businesses and industries I have audited.

My ideas for climate and nature solutions
