In accordance with Article VII, Section 2(ii) of the Elections Policy Book allowing the Chair of the Judicial Board to accept charges with merit, I hereby accept the charges for investigation brought by Robyn Walters, Director of Compliance of the Jarryd Delaney AUSG presidential campaign, against Samuel Rogers, the candidate for the Samuel Rogers AUSG presidential campaign.

Rogers stands accused of three violations. First, Walters argues Rogers violated Article I, Section 3(ii)(d) of the Elections Policy Book for using his official powers as President of the Resident Hall Association to campaign. Second, Walters argues Rogers violated Article I, Section 4(ii) of the Elections Policy Book for harassing students on behalf of his campaign who did not voluntarily give their emails to the Rogers' campaign. Third, Walters argues Rogers violated Article IV, Section 2(ii) of the Elections Policy Book for said emails not being in good taste with campaign regulations.

The inquiry has been classified as a binding election decision that will be resolved through a formal resolution. The hearing is scheduled for Friday, April 6, 2018 at 3pm in a location TBD.
