Subject: Anonymous v. Executive Board, Chief of Staff Notification of Inquiry and Dismissal

Pursuant to Article III, Section 1(iii) of the Judicial Register, allowing the Chair of the Judicial Board to “determine whether to accept or dismiss inquiries based on sufficient merit” and,

Pursuant to Article III, Section 1(i) of the Judicial Register, allowing the Chair of the Judicial Board to “decide whether an inquiry shall be considered non-binding or binding as well as whether the decision shall be considered through an informal or formal resolution;” and

Whereas the Chair of the Judicial Board received an anonymous inquiry on April 15th, 2019 inquiring whether or not every member of the Executive Board and the Chief of Staff had failed to hold their office hours, and

Whereas the inquiry also inquired whether or not the President failed in her duties by not passing any executive orders to hold any Executives accountable, and

Whereas the inquiry also inquired whether or not the Vice President had failed in her duties by failing to update the Undergraduate Senate for more than three weeks, therefore be it

Held that the Chair dismisses the inquiry based the anonymity of the inquiry.
