


Join 200 top young innovators from Australia and China and drive positive global change!

The China Australia Millennial Project (CAMP) is a world-first bilateral incubator program designed to mentor, connect and empower young Australian and Chinese leaders to co-create projects that tackle major issues faced by both countries.



WHO?

You! As one of 100 young innovators from China and 100 young innovators from Australia. If you're aged 18 to 35, with a track-record of innovative achievement in your industry, then we want YOU as one of our CAMPers.

WHAT/WHEN/WHERE?

Our 200 CAMPers will self-select into one of 20 different ThinkTanks, each with 5 Chinese and 5 Australian participants. ThinkTanks are based on major issues common to China and Australia.

The CAMP incubator will consist of:

- > A 9-week online incubator, from March 23 May 29 (4-5 hours per week on average). This is a time for research and group interaction to discover, ideate and develop your project. We expect each ThinkTank to split into two smaller teams that will each work on one project.
- > 5 days during the Vivid Ideas festival in Sydney, from June 1-5. You'll meet all 200 CAMPers and take part in a series of public forums, master classes, workshops and networking events to prototype and finesse your project. On day 5, you'll pitch your idea to angel investors, venture capitalists, talent scouts, the public and the media. You'll also get to do some seriously fun stuff, including a Sydney Harbour BridgeClimb.
- > 3 weeks of online off-ramping, **June 8-26**, to turn your ideas into action.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU?

- > Meet and collaborate with 200 top young innovators, mentored by phenomenal leaders from both countries.
- > Learn some seriously useful cross-cultural skills.
- > Create an exciting project that addresses a major global issue - your ThinkTank will own all the Intellectual Property for the project it creates.
- > Travel to Sydney, and see the city light up for the Vivid Sydney festival.
- > Cement your role as a change-maker now and in the future: CAMP, our CAMPers and your wonderful projects will receive great coverage from our many media partners.
