B. **via customer service phone number:**

If registering via telephone:

- Call JCR Customer Service at 877-223-6866 and select Option 1.
- Provide your **PRODUCT** code for the Fall 2020 program which is **CSRWEST1020**. (This code identifies the CSR Fall 2020 West Coast Webinar Series.)
- Provide your facility-specific **PROMO** code to identify you as a CSR member. (Your facility-specific PROMO code was included in the email from your CSR Consultant along with this document.)

Step 2: Learning Management System (LMS) Enrollment

SkyPrep, our LMS, provides participants with access to the conference workbook and *Zoom* link, as well as the attestation and evaluation which will be available for completion at the end of the conference.

- a. Using the enrollment link provided in the informational email, you will be directed to the *SkyPrep* enrollment page for this conference. There, you will enter your name, email, and the subscribe key provided in the informational email.
- b. Click “Register”.
- c. Enter your *SkyPrep* username (email) and password to log in. If you are new to *SkyPrep*, you will receive a system-generated email from mailer@skyprepapp.com that includes your temporary password.
- d. When you are ready to view the course, select **My Learning** from the Home page. There, you will see your registered course(s). Select the course titled ***Continuous Service Readiness: National Workshop Fall 2020 (West Coast)***.
- e. Click **Launch** to open the course.
- f. Under **Course Description**, you will see the course workbook and *Zoom* link.
- g. Click on the *Zoom* link to begin viewing the course (per the Agenda start time).

- i. Once all four (4) sessions of the course have been completed, the course will be listed as complete when selecting **Completed Courses** in the navigation pane on the left side of the page.
