



## Rules of the day

- 1.Hats to the standard EN1384, PAS 015, ASTM F 1163, AS/NZ 3838 or Snell E2001 must be worn with the chin strap fastened at all times when mounted.
- 2.All competitors must wear an effective body protector.
- 3.Medical information must be carried by all riders. Forms can be obtained from the bib collection point.
- 4.A horse/pony may compete only once per class .
- 5.Horses and ponies must be at least 4 years old.
- 6.Any horse or pony who refuses at one obstacle three times is eliminated and must move on to the next obstacle immediately. Failure to do so will result in the rider being asked to leave the course. Any eliminated rider, if continuing on the course, must give way to other competitors.
- 7.The organisers reserve the right to cancel or change any class.
- 8.Prize money may be reduced if there are insufficient entries.
- 9.Objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the results being announced and accompanied by a deposit of £15 which is returnable if the complaint is upheld.
- 10.In the event of an accident any costs to the Vet or Paramedics will be met by the injured party.
- 11.HEALTH AND SAFETY: The organisers of the event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials and stewards at all times.
- 12.In the event of adverse weather the event will be postponed. Please phone 07765496552 for further information.
- 13.After jumping faults have been taken into consideration, the winner of each class will be the competitor closest to a pre-set optimum time based on a fair hunting pace. The time will be displayed prior to the competition in the official tent. The use of timing equipment by any competitor is strictly forbidden. Unauthorised outside assistance will result in elimination.
- 14.LEGAL LIABILITY

### **Class 1: Novice Pairs. Horses or Ponies.**

Riders any age. Pair not to have won a first prize at any hunter trials. An experienced rider/horse may accompany a novice rider/horse providing they have not as a pair together won a first prize at any hunter trials.

**Fences on this shorter course are approx. 70 cm and are designed to encourage novice horses/riders.**

Entry fee £26 per pair. Barlow Hunt and Barlow Pony Club members £22 per pair.

Prizes: £20, £12, £8. Rosettes to 6th place.

### **Class 2: Novice. Horses and Ponies.**

Riders any age. Not to have won a first prize at any hunter trials.

**Fences on this shorter course are approx. 70 cm and are designed to encourage novice horses/riders.**

Entry Fee £22. Barlow Hunt and Barlow Pony Club members £20

Prizes: £20, £12, £6. Rosettes to 6th place.

Challenge Trophy to the highest placed Barlow Pony Club or adult Barlow Hunt member.

### **Class 3: Intermediate Pairs. Horses and Ponies.**

Riders any age. Intermediate or Open fences may be jumped.

**Fences : Intermediate Approx. 80 cm. Open : Approx. 100 cm**

Entry Fee £30 per pair. Barlow Hunt and Barlow Pony Club members £28 per pair

Prizes: £30, £15, £8. Rosettes to 6th place.

### **Class 4: Intermediate. Horses and Ponies.**

Rider any age. **Fences : Approx. 80 cm**

Entry Fee £26. Barlow Hunt and Barlow Pony Club members £22

Prizes: £25, £12, £6. Rosettes to 6th place.

Challenge Trophy to the highest placed Barlow Pony Club and adult Barlow Hunt member.

### **Class 5: Open. Horses and Ponies.**

Rider any age. **Fences : Approx. 100 cm**

Entry Fee £26. Barlow Hunt and Barlow Pony Club members £22

Prizes : £25, £12, £6. Rosettes to 6th place.

Challenge Trophies to the highest placed Barlow Pony Club and adult Barlow Hunt members.

**Bibs:** A **£5** refundable deposit is required upon collection of bibs.
