Approved Policy Submissions for 2021 AGM

Submission #1 – From the Langley riding association.

Amend Section 1.2 to read:

1.2. We believe in managing with the highest standards of integrity and transparency; British Columbians are entitled to full knowledge of **government operations** and services rendered.

Submission #2 – From the Langley riding association.

Amend Section 1.6 en bloc:

We believe in:

- the individual pursuit of health and happiness;
- a competitive free enterprise system as the basis for **economic** prosperity and growth **unimpeded by unwarranted regulation(s)**;
- protection and management of our environment and natural resources to optimize benefits now and into the future;
- a rigorous system of law and order that ~~also focuses~~ **respects** on the rights of victims **and optimizes deterrents**;
- ~~sustainable~~ **effective and efficient management of** a patient-centered health care **system**; • **access to student-focused** education that ~~also promotes~~ **provides opportunity for academic excellence** ~~student success~~;
- protection of the rights and freedoms of individual British Columbians;
- inter-Provincial “Free Trade” across Canada.

Submission #3 – From the Langley riding association.

New Section 5 Preamble:

Recognizing that undue strain on the health care system can be reduced when people are healthy and whole, the Conservative Party of British Columbia supports the promotion of health and wellness for all British Columbians.

Submission #4 – From the Langley riding association.

Amend 5.4.14 to read:

The Conservative Party of British Columbia recognizes that robust palliative care is key to ensuring British Columbians have meaningful choice when making end-of-life decisions. To that end, the Conservative Party of BC believes that palliative care should be appropriately

recognized, funded, and available.

Submission #5 – From the Vancouver-West End riding association.

Add section 5.4.17 to read:

A Conservative Party of British Columbia government will not fund medical assistance in dying (MaiD) for mental illness.

Submission #6 – From the Vancouver-West End riding association.

Add section 5.4.18. to read:

A Conservative Party of British Columbia government will promote a Made in BC solution to manufacture ethically-sourced vaccines, biosimilars, and drugs in the province.

Submission #7 – From the Langley riding association.

New Section 5.8 to read:

Senior Citizens

The Conservative Party of British Columbia believes in the rights and dignity for all and as such: 5.8.1 British Columbian seniors should be provided with the proper health care that they need without it being a financial burden to them.

5.8.2 Seniors should have access to in home care if they choose to remain at home.

Submission #8 – From the Vancouver-West End riding association.

*Create new section 6.5.5. to read:*

Incentivize provincial funding to British Columbian universities that have implemented Chicago Principles. Such a mandate would mean schools must abide by and protect freedom of expression as it is described in the Charter. Failure to protect free expression would result in losing provincial funding.

Submission #9 – From the Vancouver-West End riding association.

Add section 7.2.10. to read:

A Conservative Party of British Columbia government will promote a Made in BC solution to stop the export of Canadian plastic waste from being dumped or landfilled in foreign countries.

Submission #10 – From the Vancouver-West End riding association.

Amend section 17.6.1. to read:

~~Change the British Columbia portion of the donation tax credit from~~

~~non-refundable to refundable for the first \$500 of charitable giving.~~

Recognize that British Columbian charities provide essential services to our communities and that they are well-equipped to enhance the well-being of our communities. As such, we believe that charitable donations should not receive any less favorable treatment than political donations.

Submission #11 – From the Langley riding association.

Amend Article 19.1 to read:

**Immigration**

The Conservative Party of British Columbia will create a BC Best immigration policy, that ensures the economic values are prioritized. The CPBC party will initiate a transparent process to review and recommend practices that will contribute to the prosperity of BC. Specifically, this process will review sector specific requirements, skilled labour requirements, assisting businesses in identifying labour objectives and needs, fast tracking skilled and professional sectors (ie. Nurses, engineers, etc. ) to obtain qualifications related to their field of expertise.
