
Dear Wiho Papenbrock:

**RE: Article 8.2(e)**

When training falls on an employee's work day and the length of their scheduled shift is longer than the training, the employee may select from the following options:

1. Return to the workplace and complete the remainder of their shift;
2. Deduct the remaining hours from a leave bank;
3. Make up the shortfall hours based on calculations completed by the Employer every quarter. The hours owed may be applied to future approved Adult Custody training;
4. Request leave without pay for the remaining hours.
