

#### 4. CHANGE AUGUST PRIMARY TO APRIL

1 **WHEREAS**, the State of Wisconsin will hold partisan election primaries in August and  
2 the general election in November; and

3  
4 **WHEREAS**, the August primary does not allow time for a candidate to build a coalition of  
5 support before the November general election; and

6  
7 **WHEREAS**, the August election happens months after the state party conventions; and

8  
9 **WHEREAS**, the RPW endorsement of a candidate is unpopular at the convention; and

11 **WHEREAS**, moving the primary to April eliminates the need for party convention  
12 endorsements; now, therefore, be it

13  
14 **RESOLVED**, That the Republican Party of Wisconsin's Eighth Congressional District, in  
15 Caucus assembled, recommends the elimination of the August partisan primary and  
16 that the partisan primary be moved to occur simultaneously with the April non-partisan  
17 election; be it further

18  
19 **RESOLVED**, That the Republican Party of Wisconsin's Eighth Congressional District, in  
20 Caucus assembled, recommends that when there are more than two partisan primary  
21 candidates, and when a single candidate does not receive 50 percent or more of the  
22 vote, that the two top vote-getters would then have a runoff election in June.
