Order of Events:

- Arrival and pre survey (15 minutes)

- Post survey (5-10 minutes)

1. Describe your job and a typical day at work.
2. Briefly discuss advantages and disadvantages of your job.
3. Describe personal interests and abilities that you have developed that relate to your career.
4. Explain how you use skills that you have learned in school.
5. Give examples of how respect and responsibility benefit you and your co-workers.
