Requirements for registration:

All new students are encouraged to know the basic rules and moves *before attending class*. This basic knowledge is available at no charge on our website and our 'practice site' (Chess.com). **Students who have not yet learned these basics may not be fully involved until they have done so.**

C&O Family Chess Center offers unique programs aimed at nurturing a love of the game of chess, and offering students and families the means to develop their skills to the highest levels. **Parents are as essential as coaches by encouraging students to practice regularly on Chess.com and come to class on time and prepared.** We will create a free 'Chess.com' account for each new student. Parents must 'activate' the account using their club-contact E-mail once it has been created. This 'between classes' portion of the club is essential for the full benefit of our program.
