## Christopher Columbus Park, April 14th, 1–3 PM

**Travel Information:** Christopher Columbus Park is conveniently located next to the MBTA Blue Line’s Aquarium stop. For those who wish to drive, street parking is very limited, but paid parking garages are available along Atlantic Avenue.

**Ride Share Options:** Please direct your ride share drop-off and pick-ups responsibly, as Christopher Columbus Park is on a major surface road. To avoid congestion, consider using the address “1 Central Wharf, Boston, MA 02110” to direct your driver to the nearby New England Aquarium’s pick-up and drop-off points.

### Accessibility

**Via Public Transportation:** Most access points to Christopher Columbus Park are wheelchair accessible, except directly at Cross and Atlantic (see map). An area has been designated with hard surface access specifically for persons with accessibility concerns, shown on this map in purple. If you have a specific need or request, please reach out and we will do our best to ensure that all persons wishing to attend the March for Science are able to do so equally.

**Note:** Currently the elevator on the Central Wharf side of the Blue Line’s Aquarium stop is under construction. Please use the elevator at the State Street exit of the Aquarium stop—not the State Street stop (see map).

**Via “The Ride”:** Please use the address “296 State St, Boston, MA 02109” for drop-off and pick-up via “The Ride.”
