## **BGCW Awarded Carol M. White Grant** from the Department of Education

In September 2010, the Boys & Girls Club of Whittier was awarded a three-year grant through the Carol M. White Physical Education Program (PEP). BGCW was one of only 77 grant recipients throughout the nation and only one of two Boys & Girls Clubs that received funding this year.

The PEP grant is enabling the Boys & Girls Club of Whittier to develop and implement the programs necessary



to ensure that every Club member receives 60 minutes a day of physical activity, access to lifelong physical recreation activities like walking and biking on the Greenway Trial, the education and tools needed to learn how to track their daily consumption of fruits and vegetables, as well as weekly nutrition and cooking classes.


