- To decrease substance misuse among pregnant and postpartum women
- To increase safe and healthy pregnancies and improve birth outcomes
- To prevent mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders among the children
- To improve parenting skills, family functioning, economic stability, and quality of life
- To preserve families

**IN PARTNERSHIP** with the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), CLARE Foundation has established a 30-bed Residential Treatment Program for pregnant and postpartum women and their children up to age 17.

**THE PPW PROGRAM** will offer these services:

- Clinical and Substance Use Assessment
- 4-6 months residential treatment for pregnant and postpartum women and their children
- Individual, group and family therapy
- Wraparound supportive services for health care, housing, child care and social services
- Sober living
