Why CLARE|MATRIX?

Our expertise in residential treatment, coupled with our behavioral health services will provide a full continuum of care for pregnant and postpartum women and their families.

In partnership with the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), CLARE|MATRIX has established a 30-bed Residential Treatment Program for pregnant and postpartum women and their children up to age 17.



Program Services

- 4-6 month residential treatment for pregnant and postpartum women and their children
- Wraparound supportive services for health care, housing, child care, and social services
- Clinical and Substance Use Assessment
- Individual, group and family therapy
- Sober living



Who Can Be Referred?

- Pregnant Women with a Substance Use Disorder and their Children
- Women who gave birth within 12 months with Substance Use Disorders and their Children

Why?

- To decrease substance misuse among pregnant and postpartum women, and preserve families
- To increase safe and healthy pregnancies and improve birth outcomes
- To improve parenting skills, family functioning, economic stability, and quality of life
