Dear Minister D'Ambrosio,

Plastic does not go away. We must act now to stop plastic getting into our waterways. Queensland has announced that they will act on plastic pollution, identified as a key threatening process in the Senate Inquiry in 2016. What is Victoria waiting for?

Here is a checklist of four key actions needed to reduce plastic pollution entering Australia's marine environment - widely supported by the community:

- A world-class '**Cash For Containers**' system
- A ban on single-use **plastic bags**
- A ban on products containing **microbeads**
- Ending microplastic pollution eg nurdle spills, from industrial sites by enforcing existing laws.

**Victoria has only done one by agreeing to a national ban on microbeads. When will your government take action on the three other critical steps?**
