

Options for NFP's and Community Organisations to get involved

1. Setup a Container Refund Point (CRP) and / or
2. Setup Container Donation Points
3. Organise Donation collections from events etc

1. Container Refund Points

- Appointed by The Product Responsibility Organisation (PRO) to collect, sort and aggregate eligible deposit containers.
- The CRP is responsible for the payment of deposits (10 cents per container) to individuals, businesses and commercial and non-commercial institutions.
- The CRP is permitted to collect containers on a donated basis from individuals, businesses and commercial and non-commercial institutions where the refund amount is donated to the CRP operator.
- The CRP is permitted to enter into agreements for the purpose of collecting and paying the deposit value for eligible containers.
- The CRP is required to establish a commercially binding contract with the PRO in order to conduct business under the scheme.

Barriers

- Cost, CRP's will require a substantial investment in land (Depot Location), Equipment (Trucks, Forklifts, Sorting Equipment, Collection containers (eg Wheelie Bins, Industrial Bins and Cages) and Staff.



- Competition - This business is the realm of large scale commercial waste and recycle operators.

2. Container Donation Points

- No licence or commercial agreement with PRO required to operate a Donation Point
- May be some council approval required – although yet to be determined
- Can enter into agreement with a Refund Point operator to supply and service the collection bin, or cage.
- Can expect to receive the full 10c per container collected or donated.
- Ideal level for NFP's and Community Organisations. (Schools, P&C associations, C&K Kindergartens, Sporting Clubs, Special Interest Associations)

3. Donation Collections without site

- No licence or commercial agreement with PRO required to operate a Donation Point
- Need to arrange collections with event organisers/others
- Could enter into agreement with a Refund Point operator to supply and service the collection bins
- Can expect to receive the full 10c per container collected or donated.
- Ideal level for NFP's and Community Organisations without an appropriate site or unlikely to collect significant containers

Donation Points-How will this level will work?

The club or association has 2 options

1. Supply its own Container collection bin (Wheelie Bin/ Industrial Bin, and when full take this to a Refund point to be paid the 10c per approved container. (self-manage)
2. Enter into an agreement with a Refund Point Operator under a commercial arrangement (Contract) or Memorandum of Understanding

- ❖ Supply of a Container Collection Bin or Bins – size appropriate to volume and timing of collections
- ❖ Servicing – Exchange of full for empty Collection Bin
- ❖ Payment of Refund to the Donation point operator.
