



# Want Your Own Garden? Don't Have the room or space?

**Have your OWN garden at the Bordentown Township Community Garden.**

The Environmental Commission/Green Team  
will be providing garden plots at the Township's Community Garden located at 26 W. Constitution Drive.

- ✓ Garden plots will be approximately 4ft x 12ft. Smaller or larger plots can be arranged based upon availability.
- ✓ Plot availability (limited) will be on a first come - first served basis.
- ✓ There will be a one-time (non-refundable) registration fee of \$25.00 for the year.
- ✓ You will be required to provide at least 2 hours a month community time, assisting with the gardens overall maintenance and harvesting etc. during scheduled work sessions.
- ✓ The garden will open the beginning of May and all plots will be tilled and ready for planting.
- ✓ You will then be on your own to plant/maintain/water/weed your garden plot as you wish (bring your own tools). You will have access to the garden dawn till dusk.
- ✓ Water barrels will be available and we will maintain them as best as possible, however, watering is on you between fillings of the rain barrels.
- ✓ You can only harvest from your own plots. You are on the Honor System.
- ✓ The Environmental Commission, Green Team or Township will not be responsible for, or in any way liable for, maintaining your plots. We will maintain our plants, the garden common areas, pathways etc.
- ✓ The garden is an Organic Garden, all gardeners **MUST** agree to use only Organic approved fertilizers and pest controls. They must be OMRI approved/listed for organic use.
