

# **PUBLIC WORKS REMINDERS**

### BULK PICK-UP (ZONE 1): 1ST & 3RD MONDAY OF EACH MONTH BULK PICK-UP (ZONE 2&3): 2ND & 4TH MONDAY OF EACH MONTH

#### **BULK ITEMS ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

- Large Furniture, (desks, dressers, hutches etc.)
- Couches
- Wooden bed frames
- Tables
- Mattresses (They must be bagged. Mattress bags are available at the Public Works Facility)
- Minor homeowner construction items (toilets, bathtubs, vanities, etc.)

### BAGGED OR BOXED ITEMS (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PROPERLY BAGGED MATTRESSES) WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.

### **NON-BULK ITEMS & HOW TO DISPOSE OF THEM:**

- Place bagged trash in your regular trash can.
- Bagged grass goes into your regular trash can.
- Do not place cardboard boxes filled with trash at the curb they will not be collected. Place all in your trash can.
- TV's and electronics: Do not place in regular trash; bring them to the Public Works Garage.
- Excess garbage
  - Large clean outs and large amounts of waste exceeding your trash can's capacity should be taken to the landfill directly or put into a "Bagster".
    Bagsters can be purchased at most big box home improvements stores.
  - Major Renovation project waste such as excessive amounts of carpet, padding, tiles, lumber, fencing, etc. should be taken to the landfill directly.
  - General Rule: If you can fit it into you trash can, put it in there.
- White Goods are picked up on Wednesday. Please call Public Works for an appointment. This includes:
  - Most items that can be scrapped for metal.
  - Refrigerators, dishwashers, washers, dryers, grills, metal patio furniture, etc.

## AND REMEMBER, PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THERE IS 3 FEET OF CLEARANCE AROUND YOUR TRASH CAN TO ALLOW THE TRASH SERVICE TO COLLECT THE TRASH.
