



BORDENTOWN TOWNSHIP POLICE PARTNERS WITH CITY OF ANGELS TO OFFER C.A.R.E PROGRAM

C.A.R.E. (Community Addiction Recovery Effort) is a standard operating procedure followed by the Bordentown Township Police Department when suspects are arrested for drug or alcohol offenses, suffer an overdose or walk into police headquarters seeking help.

C.A.R.E. allows police officers to offer a pathway to recovery by providing resources, access to treatment, and guidance from a trained City of Angels drug counselor.

Bordentown Township Police will provide the counselor and the person struggling with addiction with a safe, private setting to discuss the process of getting the help needed to begin the recovery process.

C.A.R.E. is of the belief that every crisis is a window of opportunity, and the key to the program's success is to take a leading role in the recovery process with immediate intervention.
