**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BORDENTOWN DEFINING A
CONSTRUCTION OFFICIAL AND CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF BORDENTOWN**

ORDINANCE NO. 2002- 11

WHEREAS, the positions of Construction Official and Code Enforcement Officer (Zoning Enforcement Officer) are in need of definitional clarity; and

WHEREAS, the current Municipal Code does not have a definitive definition of these two positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Bordentown, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Chapter 25:202 is hereby amended to include the following definitions of Construction Official and Code Enforcement Officer (Zoning Enforcement Officer):

- (a) **Construction Official:** Operating under direction of the Township Administrator, the position of Construction Official has chief responsibility for administering and enforcing the provisions of the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code and various municipal ordinances, and he does other related duties as required. Included in this position is the supervision of all subcode officials to ensure proper and accurate fees, applications, inspections, and issuance of construction permits.
- (b) **Code Enforcement Officer (Zoning Enforcement Officer):** Operating under the direction of the Construction Official, the Code Enforcement Officer performs various types of field and office work involved in ensuring that residents, business places, and citizens comply with various municipal ordinances other than the State Sanitary Code, State Uniform Construction Code, or any of its subcodes or the State Uniform Fire Code, and does other duties as required.
