

TOWNSHIP OF BORDENTOWN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BORDENTOWN ADDING RETAIL AND WHOLESALE DEFINITIONS TO THE LAND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE.

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-1

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Bordentown recognizes the need to define retail and wholesale uses within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Bordentown acknowledges the need to provide further clarification of permitted uses within the various zoning districts of the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Bordentown that Ordinance No. 25:202 be amended to add the following definitions in the alphabetically appropriate positions:

Retail: The sale of goods to ultimate consumers for personal or household consumption and not bulk sale of goods to customers engaged in the business of reselling goods.

Wholesale: The sale of goods primarily to customers engaged in the business of reselling the goods.
