1. **SALUTE TO FLAG:** Chairman Plew called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM and led those present in a salute to the flag.

6. **NEW BUSINESS: Planning Board update:** Chairman Plew and Mr. Grayson led a discussion about development around the marshlands and agreed that the EC would draft a statement expressing environmental concerns.
7. **FOR DISCUSSION: Green Team:** Fall Clean-up is scheduled for the bike path on November 16. Community Garden cleanup continues. The compost will not be available until spring. The Veterans Day Ceremony will be held at the Senior Center at 11:00 am.
