

**WHEREAS**, he was able to retain federally funded grant reimbursements to repair the damages due to Hurricane Irene that included replacement of the storm water drainage systems and other required repairs for a combined total from all the application in the amount of 1.79 million dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, he also initiated tracking and monitoring Right-to-Know of hazardous chemicals and organized and coordinated critical hazardous training for First Responders and Township Emergency Operations Plans, (EOP), and hazard mitigation plans and continued to identify areas of critical infrastructure, such as the, **culvert project on Orchard Avenue and Glen Road** ;and

**WHEREAS**, Andy worked professionally with the First Responders, Township Officials, the Emergency Management Team and the county and state levels of Emergency Management to achieve a level of success and safety for the residents of this Township;
