1. **SALUTE TO FLAG:** Chairman Plew called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM and led those present in a salute to the flag.
2. **OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ANNOUNCEMENT BY CHAIRMAN:** In compliance with the open Public Meetings Act, this is to announce that adequate notice of this meeting was provided in the following manner: On March 17 advance written notice of this meeting was posted on the bulletin board opposite the main entrance of the meeting room in the Municipal Building; was faxed to the BURLINGTON COUNTY TIMES and the TIMES OF TRENTON; was filed with the Clerk of Bordentown Township, and was mailed to all persons who requested and paid for such service.
3. **MINUTES:** Motion to adopt the minutes of the May 16, 2017 meeting was made by Vice Chair.Veselka and seconded by Mrs. Lozito. Motion carried unanimously.
4. **LIASON REPORT:** Committeeman Fuzy shared the latest information about Elcon. They failed the technical review and must come back again in a minimum of 90 days.
5. **NEW BUSINESS:** A discussion was held concerning changing the meeting dates to the first Monday of each month to coincide with Planning Board meetings. Chairman Plew suggested a modification of an ordinance to obtain enough copies of plans for EC members. Committeeman Fuzy will review the procedure.
6. **FOR DISCUSSION:**
 - Green Team Update:** A date has been set for the next Green Team Meeting. It will be held at Joseph Lawrence Park on July 19 at 6:00 in the pavilion.
 - Free tree seedlings** from the state are still available.
 - Community Garden:** Members discussed a work schedule for maintenance and harvesting. Members Chairman Plew noted the need for a drive-through gate to allow larger equipment into the garden. He made a motion to allot \$500 for this improvement. Mrs. Cann seconded and motion carried unanimously. Chairman Plew also advised that there is no working lawn mower and made a motion that the EC allot \$300 for the purchase of a new mower. Vice-Chair Veselka seconded and motion carried unanimously.
 - Fishing Derby:** The EC will man the concession stand at the Fishing Derby at Northern Community Park.
 - Sustainable Jersey Points:** Chairman Plew asked members to find 20 points worth of actions to work on.
