1. **SALUTE TO FLAG:** Chairman Plew called the meeting to order at 7:35 PM and led those present in a salute to the flag.
2. **OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ANNOUNCEMENT BY CHAIRMAN:** In compliance with the open Public Meetings Act, this is to announce that adequate notice of this meeting was provided in the following manner: On February 12, 2016 advance written notice of this meeting was posted on the bulletin board opposite the main entrance of the meeting room in the Municipal Building; was mailed to the Register-News and the Burlington County Times; was filed with the Clerk of Bordentown Township, and was mailed to all persons who requested and paid for such notice.
3. **MINUTES:** Minutes from the November 21, 2017 meeting were tabled until the January meeting.
 - **LIAISON REPORT:** Deputy Mayor Fuzy discussed the housing development planned for Rt. 130 that will move the township toward fulfilling its affordable housing quota. He informed members that Bill Grayson will be joining the commission in January.
4. **OLD BUSINESS:** Sustainable Jersey Actions: A grant of \$3,000 - \$4,000 will be needed to implement the Community Forest Plan. Chairman Plew estimated that the brownfields action would require approximately \$1,000.
5. **NEW BUSINESS:** Chairman Plew informed members about the pipeline permit for Rising Sun Meadows LLC and shared a letter from DEP about the groundwater at the Yates/Circuit Foil property.
6. **FOR DISCUSSION:** Terra Cycle: Members will continue to look at programs that do not require the purchase of collection boxes.
Green Challenge: Ideas are needed for the new challenge.
