We have an exciting new program to announce! We are participating in the TerraCycle's Zero-Waste program, which means we are collecting non-recyclable packaging to reduce waste. This **free** collection program will help us to keep tons of garbage from ending up in our landfill.

You can help by bringing your empty oral care packaging materials shown below this letter as well as empty snack wrappers, potato chip/popcorn bags etc. and candy wrappers to the Township Public Works Recycling Center, 266 Crosswicks. **We have dedicated collection containers for these specific recyclables.**

In addition we have collection bins available and set up in each school so your children can participate and learn the importance of recycling. Although the Oral Care program is sponsored by Colgate, all brands are accepted. We will send them to TerraCycle. As an eco-friendly innovator, TerraCycle will **upcycle** the materials we collect into cool new eco-friendly and affordable products that are available at major retailers. The products are made directly from used packaging of recognizable brands. The TerraCycle programs are an easy way for us to make a difference locally and globally.

The major factor here is reducing trash to the landfill.
